


Adding GIS Services to ArcView



When working in ArcView, you are not limited to only your data, but can also use data served from other sites. The data connections are set up in ArcCatalog under GIS Servers. ESRI has many online maps available by connecting through this URL:


Note: For online tasks, such as address locating, try ESRI's task server:


1. In ArcMap, click 'Add Data'



2. In the Add Data dialog box, double-click on 'GIS Servers'




3. Double-Click on 'Add ArcGIS Server'.



4. In the Add ArcGIS Server dialog box, select **'Use GIS Services'**.




5. In the General dialog box, select Internet, and enter the Server URL: **<http://server.arcgisonline.com/arcgis/services>**



6. Click **Finish**.


Note: Once the ArcGIS Server has been added to ArcGIS, you will not have to load it again. It will show up in your list of GIS Servers.

7. The ArcGISOnline server will now show in your list of GIS Servers. Double-Click on the newly added server name.



8. A list appears of all the online services available from ESRI. Select ESRI_StreetMap_World_2D and then click 'Add'.

The streetmap basemap should appear in your table of contents.
